Qualifications:

- Minimum age of 18
- In agreement with the UR Statement of Faith
- Active member/regular at church and committed to growth in their personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Relates well to children at all grade levels in a positive and nurturing manner.
- Experience working with children is preferred.
- Must be able to pass child abuse background check.
- Currently obtains or willing to obtain the following trainings within the first three months of start date (free):
 - First Aid/CPR
 - Mandatory Child Abuse Reporter
 - Child Care Essential Pre-Service Training
- Must be physically able to effectively work indoors and outdoors.
- Must be able to frequently assume postures at low levels to allow physical and visual contact with children, see and hear well enough to keep children safe, and engage in physical activity with children.

Responsibilities:

- Supervises children and is mindful of their safety at all times, ensuring that first aid is given to all children in need.

- Demonstrates a customer service focus through a display of courtesy, service, cooperation, hospitality, sensitivity, and professionalism
- Serves as a positive role model for all children.
- Establishes a professional relationship with parents, greeting them at drop-off time.
- Cleans up afterward.
- Circulates among the children and is alert to their needs.
- Maintains a clean, orderly, and safe space for children.
- Communicates with the Director as needed on any child safety or discipline issues.
- Performs all other duties as assigned.
